

Please Recycle

THIS NEWSPAPER AND ALL OTHER RECYCLABLE MATERIALS.

Here's How and Where:

NEWSPAPER:

Place in paper bags. Do not mix magazines with the newspapers. No plastic bags please.

OFFICE PAPER:

White, mixed and junk mail is recyclable. Please keep each separated and place in paper bags. Accepted at all collection centers.

MAGAZINES AND BOOKS:

Place in paper bags and please keep separated from newspaper. Hard and soft bound books, phone books and catalogs.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD:

Only 3-layer cardboard and paper grocery bags. Flatten all boxes. No waxed cardboard or single layer paperboard (e.g. cereal, tissue, shoe boxes).

GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS:

Remove lids, rinse and sort bottles and jars by clear, amber or green. No window glass, pyrex, light bulbs, mirrors or drinking glasses.

PLASTIC BOTTLES #1 & #2 ONLY:

Look for the number on the bottom of the bottle. Remove caps, rinse, crush jugs. (No motor oil containers). Separate milk jugs and place in marked bin.

ALUMINUM:

Aluminum cans, frozen dinner trays, pie pans, clean aluminum foil, lawn furniture, windows and door frames can be recycled. Please rinse and remove all materials which are not aluminum (steel, plastic, etc.).

TIN CANS:

Rinse and remove the label. Tin can lids may be included.

PLASTIC BAGS & FILM:

Clean & Empty. Plastic grocery and dry cleaning bags & shrink wrap (no hard plastic, bubble wrap or styrofoam).

Take these items to the transfer station recycling centers only:

CLOTHING & SMALL APPLIANCES

Accepted at all Transfer Stations, except Roseburg.

USED MOTOR OIL:

Collect motor oil in non-breakable containers with tight fitting screw-top lids. Automatic transmission fluid and hydraulic oil can be mixed with motor oil for recycling. Empty into oil holding tanks located at attended transfer sites.

ALL METALS:

Accepted at the Roseburg and Reedsport Transfer Site **ONLY**.

WOOD WASTE:

Separate all wood demolition materials and place in designated areas at the transfer sites. To avoid damage to the tub grinder the removal of bolts, wire, concrete, metal, plastic, etc. is requested.

YARD WASTE:

Separate yard waste; grass cuttings, tree branches, bush and plant trimmings, etc. from your waste, place on the designated paved area at the transfer sites.

ANTIFREEZE RECYCLING PROGRAM:

Take to nearest public antifreeze recycling station (small fee may apply). Myrtle Creek - Douglas Radiator; Roseburg - Koble's Automotive, Quality Radiator; Sutherlin - M&P Auto Service.

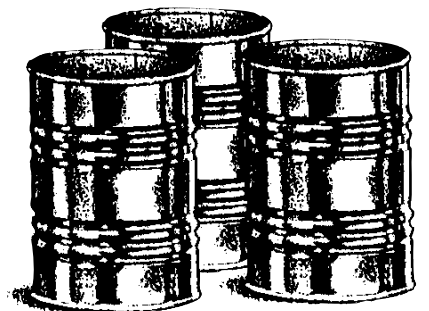
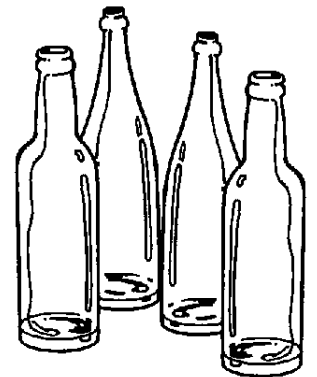
