Yoncalla Recycles

Douglas County Transfer stations not only dispose of your trash, they are also the place to recycle many kinds of items!

An average person (and that includes you!) can reduce their trash by 30-40% through recycling. You can recycle many different things at your local Transfer Station & Recycle Depot. Here are some examples:

Newspaper Everything that comes with the newspaper can be recycled, too. Bring it in paper bags or just stack it up. No plastic bags or string.

Cardboard Only the three-layer kind with a wavy middle. **Brown grocery bags** can go in with the cardboard.

Paper White paper, mixed paper, even junk mail! Bring in paper bags. Pop and beer boxes OK! No food or oil contamination

Magazines/Catalogs All glossy paper, posters, and brochures.

Aluminum Cans, clean foil, pie pans, and dinner trays.

Plastic Milk/water jugs, and all bottles, tubs, trays, and film. No food or oil contamination.

Scrap Metal Fencing, pipe, aluminum window frames, lawn furniture. No car parts or items over 40lbs.

Wood Waste Any wood, pallets, or construction debris. No wire, concrete, bolts, hinges, or doorknobs. (Those damage the grinder)

Your local transfer station is the Yoncalla Disposal Site & Recycle Depot

The Disposal Site & Recycle Depot is located one mile north of Yoncalla, on Yoncalla Transfer Road, off of Drain-Yoncalla Hwy 389.

For your convenience, the Depot is open from 10 am to 6pm, Wednesday through Sunday. It is closed Monday, Tuesday, and Holidays.

Recycling is easiest if you plan ahead by separating at home.

You are going to the Depot anyway, so you might as well recycle!
