

**DOUGLAS COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT
SPECIAL WASTE DISPOSAL FEES**

Animal By Products

\$60.00 per ton

Appliances

Residential (small - washer, dryer, range, etc.)	\$ 5.00 each
Residential (large - refrigerator, freezer, etc.)	\$15.00 each
Commercial Sizes	\$25.00 each

Construction and Demolition Waste

Construction and demolition (C&D) waste in excess of one (1) cubic yard is only accepted at the Roseburg Landfill (\$60.00 per ton) and at the Reedsport Transfer Station (\$15.00 per cubic yard).

Infectious Medical Waste

Commercial Sharps - \$10.00 per gallon size container
Residential Sharps - No charge
All sharps must be in proper container (red, rigid plastic with lid)

Mattresses

\$8.00 per unit (mattress or box spring). Mattresses only accepted at the Roseburg Landfill and Reedsport Transfer Station.

Out of County Household Waste

\$70.00 per ton (\$28.00 per cubic yard). Waste only accepted at the Roseburg Landfill and the following transfer stations: Camas Valley, Glendale, Reedsport, Roseburg, Yoncalla, and Tiller.

Permitted Waste

(Asbestos, Boiler Residue, Petroleum Contaminated Soil, Sand Blast Grit and other material)

Fee of \$72.00 (permit and disposal) for residential homeowner generated asbestos disposal of 1 (one) cubic yard or less. All other asbestos and permitted waste disposal at \$72.00 permit fee each site plus \$60.00 per ton (one ton minimum charge). Permits are available at Room 220, Douglas County Courthouse. Phone 541-440-4485 for permit information. Waste must be tested prior to disposal for contaminants per County staff direction.

Soil, Sand, Gravel, Crushed Rock

\$9.00 per ton, \$9.00 minimum fee up to one ton. Homeowner charge exemption for 2 cubic yards per day at the Roseburg Landfill and ½ cubic yard per day at transfer stations. Testing may be required at discretion of solid waste staff. If testing is required, fees will be determined based on test results.

Tires - includes motorcycle, ATV, equipment and tractor tires (must be off the rim)

All tires up to 15"	\$ 2.00 each
All tires 16" to 19.5"	\$ 6.00 each
All solid rubber tires and tires larger than 19.5"	\$20.00 each or \$340.00 per ton

Bicycle and wheelbarrow tires are exempt

Tree Stumps (12 inch diameter and larger)

\$60.00 per ton

Vehicle Parts

Whole or half bodies	\$67.00 each
Major parts (hood, fender, engine, transmission)	\$20.00 each
Vehicle seats - no charge	

Vehicles must be cleaned of all garbage and debris. Tires must be removed.

Disposal limited to two pickup loads or five cubic yards per day at transfer stations.

Disposal for all waste other than household waste generated outside of Douglas County will be charged at double the disposal rates listed above. Douglas County reserves the right to reject out of county generated waste for disposal.
